**Re: Next EFFAT Executive Committee – 3 June 2013**

Dear Colleagues,

As we already announced, the next meeting of the EFFAT Executive Committee was planned on 3-4 June 2013 but EESC (European Economic and Social Committee) unfortunately informed us that the meeting cannot take place at the meeting room which was planned because of technical problems.

The European Parliament has now informed us that we can use a meeting room with 6 interpretation booths in their premises but **only on 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2013**. It is a bigger meeting room but no other rooms were available for our interpretation needs.

This means that:

- 1) the Management Committee will be cancelled as the only agenda item was dealing with the financial report 2012. But we will distribute the report in advance to the members of the Management Committee for their comments and endorsement.
- 2) we will need to postpone certain agenda items to the next Executive Committee meeting and thus focus on the most important items namely the discussion with Paolo Di Castro, Chair of the Committee on Agriculture and Rural Development on CAP reform and Eveline Regner, MEP, Vice Chair of Legal Affairs Committee on posting of workers directive.

A revised draft agenda will be sent as soon as possible.

- 3) The procedure to have access to the European parliament is much more complicated. We therefore ask all participants to meet at the entrance/reception of the Altiero Spinelli (ASP) building at **8.30** so that we can start at 9.00.(see map enclosed) .
